ARE YOU LOOKING FOR AN ANGLE?



Chances are QPI has it! Perforated "infill" panels are different from expanded metal or wire mesh panels because margins or borders can be supplied, eliminating the need to weld or secure the rough edges within framework, or by the

use of U-edging. This of course will eliminate extra labor and save on both time and money.

But what happens when these infill panels are used running up a staircase? Traditional perforating practice has been that it was not possible to leave a consistent margin on the angle and the aesthetic value of the panels would be compromised. You may have seen attempts at this where the top and bottom of the parallelograms had an incomplete "saw tooth" appearance. Not very pleasing from an aesthetic viewpoint!

QPI however, has the unique ability to follow the angle with the perforations and maintain a consistent, complete look that is both easy
